The year has been a busy one for our school. We have achieved many milestones and have been successful in our efforts to provide a high quality education for our students. Our staff and students have worked hard to make this year a successful one.

Our financial performance has been excellent. We have achieved a surplus of \$1.2 million for the year, which is a significant improvement on the \$0.5 million surplus achieved in 2008. This is due to a number of factors, including a 1% increase in donations, a 0% increase in fees, and a 1% increase in other income. We have also managed to reduce our operating costs by 1%.

Our academic performance has also been excellent. We have achieved a 95% pass rate in our Year 12 exams, which is a significant improvement on the 90% pass rate achieved in 2008. This is due to a number of factors, including a 1% increase in the number of students who achieved a distinction, a 0% increase in the number of students who achieved a credit, and a 1% increase in the number of students who achieved a pass.

We have also achieved a number of other milestones, including the opening of our new library and the completion of our new sports centre.
